# WILMINGTON DRAMA LEAGUE COME HANG OUT WITH US 5 Lesbians Eating Ouiche

### President's Letter

I am thrilled by the line up we have in place for the 92<sup>nd</sup> Season at the Wilmington Drama League. We have something for everyone and invite our audience to experience and see things that you didn't think were possible.

We are starting off the  $92^{nd}$  season with *Carrie*, the 70s prom night horror movie come to life on stage in September. Carrie White is the awkward teenage girl with telekinetic powers who is tormented by her classmates and her cruel, fanatical mother. Reserve a great seat early for this production of Steven King's classic story.

The mysterious *Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time* will keep theater fans guessing in October. This play is adapted by Simon Stephens from Mark Haddon's novel and tells the story of 15-year-old Christopher, his extraordinary brain, and the mystery of his neighbors' murdered dog. Dark comedy is on the menu when we present *5 Lesbians eating a Quiche* in November. Described as "raw magnetic dementia," co-authors Evan Linder and Andrew Hobgood have created a show destined to have a cult following. It's 1956 and the "Susan B. Anthony Society for the Sisters of Gertrude Stein" are having their annual quiche breakfast, but not everything is perfect in this little town.

This holiday season, the Wilmington Drama League is overjoyed to be presenting *Mary Poppins*. This show needs very little in the way of introduction. The story of the magical nanny has captured the hearts of generations.

We will kick off 2025 with *The Full Monty* in January. *The Full Monty* with book by Terrence McNally and score by David Yazbek is sure to impress. Based on the 1997 film, six unemployed steelworkers in Buffalo open their minds to becoming adult entertainers and work through their fears, self-consciousness, and anxieties. We watch as they overcome their inner demons and find strength in their friendship.

In March, we invite you with to our production of *Tick, Tick...BOOM!*. The semi-autobiographical musical by Jonathan Larson tells the story of an aspiring composer struggling to know if he has chosen the right career pursuing the arts. It is an intimate, but energetic production that you will want to experience first hand.

This April, *I Hate Hamlet* by Paul Rudnick will delight audiences. The play follows successful television actor Andrew Rally as he struggles with taking on the dream role of Hamlet. He is joined by a host of wild characters including the ghost of John Barrymore, who has come to haunt him into playing the tragic role of Hamlet.

Our second Black box production of the season will be in May when we present *August:* Osage *County* author Tracy Letts', *Bug.* The play tells the story of a woman who increasingly spends time in her motel room with a new acquaintance. As she slowly begins to share in his paranoia and conspiracy theories, she may be losing her grip on her sanity with shattering consequences.

We close out the 92<sup>nd</sup> season in June with present *Hairspray*. Set in 1962 Baltimore, the production follows teenage Tracy Turnblad's dream to dance on "The Corny Collins Show", a local TV dance show. In 2003 *Hairspray* won the Tony for Best Musical and is a real crowd pleaser.

I am excited to see each production this season and to see all of you again in the audience, backstage, or maybe even onstage. We could not do what we do at The Wilmington Drama League without all the effort and time gifted to us buy our volunteers. We are proud to provide so many opportunities to our community to participate in and create live theater.

I invite everyone who has enjoyed our productions in the past, or who loves to participate in our shows to bring a friend with you this season. Make this the season you share your passion for the performing arts with someone new!


