The Drama League is Wilmington's oldest community theatre, and the best equipped.





The lobby is spacious, comfortable and features a cash bar.






The auditorium is well raked and comfortably seats over 200 patrons.





The stage is a proscenium arch with a thrust.
The playing area is 30 feet wide, 12 feet tall and roughly 40 feet deep!





The stage sits over an orchestra pit. The deck can be equipped with trap doors. The auditorium is cooled by quiet air conditioning.





The theatre has ample fly space, and is equipped with 16 counter-weighted, easy to operate flies.








The technical booth is situated well above the theatre. It features state of the art, easy to program and operate lighting and audio systems. Both have about 100 potential inputs.







The shop is well equipped with power tools, and plenty of material. Shown here, it is in the midst of a set build.





Behind the theatre is a storage space where props and furniture are kept under lock and key.





The all-purpose room is spacious enough to emulate rehearsal on the Drama League stage. It is adjacent to the green room.





The dressing rooms both have private toilet facilities and plenty of room for casts of any size to prepare for the show.







When the cast is not waiting in the wings, the green room is comfortable, private and is set up to provide snacks, and beverages. Not shown is a wall to wall illuminated mirror for last minute touchups.





The Drama League is particularly well suited for larger scale productions, but the playing area can easily be configured for more intimate shows.

The acoustics are great in the auditorium, so straight plays and musicals all work very well. Please consider submitting your next show to the Board of Directors! We are looking forward to connecting with you!
